


## Safety Brief #103: Taxiway Line not centered (7/1/2024)

CFI Teamsters,

RMFlight parking as you know is very busy and it is important to be diligent in your exiting and entering parking to/from the ramp. Yellow taxiway lines exist to help ensure sufficient margin on each side of the wing tips while taxiing (for our small GA size airplanes). We also teach our students and role model: "stay on centerline at all times for increased safety and professionalism".

However, we do have a parking taxiway line that is not centered (offset by 5ft from center). Pictured below, the parking taxiway line is not centered with regard to tails and props on each side making "stay centered on the yellow line" less safe.

Although we teach "Stay Centered on the yellow line", I recommend offsetting to the west by 5 feet and telling your students/renters: "although you should be on center yellow at all times, for this alley you must offset and deviate from your normal".
